Wilderness PSD will be **flushing** the entire water system the weeks of **APRIL 13 thru MAY 15, 2026.**

CAUTION SHOULD BE USED WHEN COOKING OR DOING LAUNDRY DUE TO POSSIBLE DISCOLORATION IN THE WATER.

WHAT WATER MAIN FLUSHING MEANS

Over time, minerals and other deposits can accumulate inside water mains. To clean the mains and remove these deposits, Wilderness PSD flushes the distribution main lines twice a year.

Flushing water mains involves opening a nearby fire hydrant or blow-off valve and discharging water from the hydrant or valve; the high velocity of the water cleans the inside of the mains. As this stirs up the mineral's sediment and deposits, it can cause discoloration in your water. It does not mean that there is any contamination in the water.
